Bond Withdrawal Reimbursement Policy

This is your certificate of membership. Please put it in a safe place as you will be required to return it in the event you change the type of membership or withdraw your membership. To withdraw your membership, return this certificate with a signed and dated note indicating your desire to withdraw and confirming your mailing address.

Upon receipt of your certificate you will be issued a reimbursement check for up to 75% of your bond amount. Each year that you are inactive (do not pay your dues) you will lose 20% of the full amount.

Temporary Hold and Reactivation Policy

Should you choose to put your account on hold for a summer, you must inform the Membership Coordinator in writing. You can mail a letter or send an email to willowoodswimclub@gmail.com

You can put a temporary hold on your account for one year. After one year, should you then choose to, you can withdraw your membership with no penalty or continue your membership and pay for the following summer.

If you choose not to pay your summer dues and DO NOT inform the Membership Coordinator, your account will become INACTIVE and you will automatically begin to lose part of your bond (as stated above in the Bond Withdrawal Reimbursement Policy)

If your account is inactive and you choose to REACTIVATE it, there is a \$15 reactivation fee for each year that you did not pay summer dues (up to 4 years). When you have paid your reactivation fee and summer dues your account will be reactivated and you will be entitled to the maximum bond withdrawal amount should you decide to withdraw your membership.
